

Unpaid Internship for Library Science Students

PM World, Inc. is a small digital publishing and information services company based in Addison, Texas, USA. We publish a monthly online journal at www.pmworldjournal.net, registered with the US Library of Congress as digital publication ISSN: 2330-4480. The journal has been published monthly since August 2012 and is indexed by EBSCO. Launched in February 2014, the PM World Library at www.pmworldlibrary.net provides an archive for all works published in the PM World Journal. Both the journal and library are focused on the global program and project management field, which is rapidly growing in governmental, industrial and non-profit organizations worldwide. Now organized to resemble a digital version of a more traditional library, the PM World Library is being expanded to become the world's most robust specialist library for those involved with projects of all kinds. In June 2015, access to EBSCO's Business Source Corporate Plus database was added, along with access to EBSCO Business Book Summaries database; access to other resources is being added on a regular basis.

PM World is offering several unpaid internships for library science students to conduct research, assist with populating the PM World Library and perform other activities related to the online library. Students must have their own laptop computers to perform the work. For students in the Dallas, Texas area, initial meetings and work will be in physical offices in Addison; research and other activities can be performed online from any location. For students not located near Addison, all meetings and work will be performed virtually. Successful candidates will have full free unlimited ongoing access to all contents in the library; will receive recognition on the team pages on the journal and library websites; will be introduced to PM World advisors, directors and correspondents around the world; and will receive Certificate of Completion and Letter of Recommendation on successful completion of each semester's internship. Other benefits may be added in the future. This position may or may not qualify for university credit (students are responsible for applying for university credit). Interns will be supervised by an MLS-degreed librarian. Internship will be semester based, after which students can add the experience to resume for career purposes. References required.
