

31 new works by 34 different authors added to PM World Library in March

PM World Collection grows to 1290 project management articles, papers & other works by 569 different authors in more than 50 countries

9 March 2015 – Dallas, London, Sydney – PM World has announced that 31 new articles, papers and other original works about program and project management (P/PM) were added to the PM World Library (PMWL) this month. These contributions by 34 different authors in 15 countries were published in the March 2015 edition of the ***PM World Journal*** (PMWJ). They can now be found among the most recent papers, articles and book reviews on the PMWL home page at www.pmworldlibrary.net.

The new additions bring the total in the PM World Collection to around 1290 original works by 569 different authors from 60+ countries. The collection is growing each month by approximately 30 new works by many different authors; of the 34 authors in December, 7 were new to the journal and library. According to PMWL Director David Pells, “The new works by our series authors are outstanding again this month. Russ Martinelli, Tim Rahschulte and Jim Waddell wrapped up their ‘Transition to Project Management’ series this month. Alan Stretton has provided article 4 in his important six-part series on project successes and failures. Lynda Bourne has provided her third series article related to ‘Stakeholder Engagement’. And Professors Ingason and Jonasson have authored the second article in their series on the ‘Role of Academic Institutions in Educating and Training Project Managers’.”

“Our correspondents are also stepping it up,” Pells adds. “For example, Cecilia Boggi’s report from Buenos Aires this month describes ‘the Dakar Rally, an annual competition originally from Europe to the city of Dakar, in Senegal, and since 2009 moved to the Southern Cone bringing cars, trucks, motorcycles and squads from around the world to tour the sand, rock, mud and vegetation of the beautiful and varied landscapes of Argentina, Chile and Bolivia.’ The reports from Luca Cavone in Milan, İpek Özgüler in Istanbul, Alfonso Bucero in Madrid, Emils Pulmanis in Riga and Miles Shepherd in Salisbury are nearly as interesting.”

New authors in March include **Javed Azam** (USA), **Anil Bapat** (USA), **Bärbel Häckel** (Germany), **Ramaz Issa** (UAE), **Jackie Olshack** (USA), **Ben Rendle** (UK) and **Lance Van Nostrand** (USA). New works from 27 authors already included in the library were also added.

In addition to the original papers, 40+ news articles were added to the library archives this month, bringing the total to well over 1,200 articles.
