## **Free PM World Library access for residents of Zimbabwe**

### ***Free scholar level access to project management library now available for residents of Zimbabwe and other low income countries***

Effective 1 May 2015, PM World announced a new [PMWL Scholar membership](#), to provide access to several massive EBSCO databases of business and management books, magazines, journals and other publications. Access to the Scholar level – full access to everything in the library – is now available for free to residents of low income countries. Free access is also available for a limited time to those signing up for the [Free Trial membership](#).
