34 new works by 38 different authors added to PM World Library

PM World Collection grows to more than 1450 project management articles, papers & other works by 703 different authors in more than 60 countries

14 October 2015 – Dallas, London, Sydney – PM World has announced that 34 new articles, papers and other original works about program and project management (P/PM) have been added to the PM World Library (PMWL) this month. These contributions by 38 different authors in 15 countries were published in the October 2015 edition of the ***PM World Journal*** (PMWJ). They can now be found among the most recent papers, articles and book reviews on the PMWL home page at www.pmworldlibrary.net.

The new additions bring the total in the PM World Collection to over 1450 original works by 703 different authors from 60+ countries. The collection is growing each month by 30-40 new works by many different authors; of the 38 authors this month, 19 were new to the journal and library.
