

26 new works by 33 authors added to PM World Library

PM World Collection grows to 1614 project management articles, papers & other works by 745 different authors in more than 60 countries

15 March 2016– Dallas, London, Sydney – PM World has announced that 26 new articles, papers and other original works about program and project management (P/PM) have been added to the PM World Library (PMWL) this month. These contributions by 33 different authors in 15 countries were published in the March 2016 edition of the [PM World Journal](#) (PMWJ). They can now be found among the most recent papers, articles and book reviews on the PMWL home page at www.pmworldlibrary.net.

The new additions bring the total in the PM World Collection to 1614 original works by 745 different authors in 60+ countries. The collection is growing each month by approximately 30 new works by many different authors; of the 33 authors this month, 13 were new to the journal and library. According to PMWL Director **David Pells**, “I was pretty excited about this edition of the journal. With seven featured papers and seven series articles, this is a robust edition with some very good works included. The case study is also a serious research-based paper. New works from 20 authors already included in the library were also added.

“Everyone should read Mónica González’ paper titled ‘The Legacy: Project Management for Peace’,” Pells adds. “She rightly argues that trillions of dollars of valuable resource are wasted each year through wars and fighting, resources that can be better used for projects that help society. I think we need more project management leaders to speak out on global social problems. So Bravo, Mónica!”
