The 3rd edition of International Project Management Day was held on the 1st of November 2012 in Lagos at Terra Kulture Victoria Island, Lagos with the theme “Engineering Social Change - The change begins with you”.

He discussed the different levels of social change, model for change, the change conversation and how to be the change in Nigeria.
