30 new works by 33 authors added to PM World Library

PM World Collection grows to 1835 project management articles, papers & other works by 800 different authors in more than 60 countries

New works from 22 authors already included in the library were also added.

"The second editions papers this month are also important works, especially the paper by Dr Steen Lichtenberg in Denmark," Pells adds. "I always really enjoy the advisory and commentary articles and this month is no exception. But the interview provided by Ipek Ozguler in Turkey is pretty fascinating, as are the reports from five correspondents around the world."
