



Southampton graduate student completes PMWL internship in record time

Ömer Dağlı completes project management research internship in under one month

16 February 2018 – Dallas, USA and Southampton, UK – PM World has announced that **Ömer Berkay Dağlı**, a graduate student in the business school at the University of Southampton in the UK, has completed the PM World Library's project management research internship. Ömer completed the 16-week program in just four weeks, a new record.

Ömer Berkay Dağlı is currently a Masters Candidate at Southampton Business School, University of Southampton, based in UK for the academic year 2017-2018. Previously, he has served as an Officer on Watch for over 30 months on board chemical tankers, based in different routes all round the world where he served Third and Second Officer. He completed his graduation in Marine Transportation Management dual diploma with honours from both Istanbul Technical University, Turkey and State University of New York Maritime College, USA in 2014.
