

Project Management Research Scholar Program

PM World, Inc. is a digital publishing and information services company based in Addison, Texas, USA, but owned and directed by experienced project management leaders in America, Australia and the UK. The company publishes the online *PM World Journal* (PMWJ) at www.pmworldjournal.net, registered with the US Library of Congress as digital publication ISSN: 2330-4480. The journal has been published monthly since August 2012, is indexed by EBSCO and is recognized as one of the leading online publications serving the global project management community.

Since February 2014, PM World has been building and operating the **PM World Library** (PMWL), an online portal of project management-related information at www.pmworldlibrary.net. The PMWL provides an archive for all works published in the PMWJ. Now organized to resemble a digital version of a more traditional library, the PMWL is growing into a robust specialist library for those involved with projects of all kinds. The PMWL includes access to a wide variety of resources including articles and papers by academic researchers, professional leaders and practicing professionals, as well as to public and proprietary databases. The PMWJ and PMWL are intended to be global resources for sharing knowledge and continuous learning related to program and project management (P/PM).

PM World offers free access to the PM World Library to qualified scholars who are conducting research on P/PM topics, especially research aimed at solving regional or global problems, who agree to post their research results in the PMWJ or PMWL and to help enhance the resources in the library related to her or his research topic. Candidates are expected to be PhD level graduate students, those recently granted PhD or doctoral degrees and engaged in post-graduate research, or professors of project management. Copyright for all articles and papers posted or published by scholars will remain with the authors, in accordance with Creative Commons License BY v 4.0. https://creativecommons.org/licenses/by/4.0/, but with works accessible and downloadable for personal or educational use by library members. Schedule for delivery of research results will be as agreed with the library director.

Each **Research Scholar** will have a Scholar Showcase webpage posted on the PMWL and PMWJ websites where profile, research interests/activities, and access to publications will be posted. Each scholar will also receive unlimited free access to everything in the PM World Library for five years; recognition with any research results posted in the library; introduction to PM World advisors and executives; publishing opportunities in the *PM World Journal*; certificate for wall mounting; and other benefits (to be determined). Communications and work will be performed virtually. No employment or financial payments will be involved; no legal or financial relationship will be established or implied between PM World, Inc. and participating scholars.
