Graduate of Kazakh-British Technical University in Almaty completes PM World Library research internship program

Since October 2018 he started working in the Project Control Group of the world-class company «KAZ Minerals Project B.V.» in Kazakhstan, in position - Quantity Surveyor.

Research interests: Project Management in Kazakhstan, Project Management Maturity Level in Kazakhstan, Construction and Engineering Management, Earned value management, Stakeholders Management, Projects execution and control, Supply chain and logistics management, Scheduling and planning in construction.
