This is carried out by harnessing the power of arts, media and technology to reach millions of people across the country. It provides extensive trainings for young people thereby helping them to develop an identity. It stands by people giving confidence to make a choice of taking action for girls everywhere, to an education, to safety and to life.

Breakthrough envisions a world where everyone enjoy their human rights and live with equality, dignity, respect and justice. The organization is built on the belief "Violence against women and girls can end with you" and each persons experience reflects this truth. It inspires people to fight for justice by catalysing leadership in communities, conducting campaigns and programs to bring change in behaviours and attitudes.
