## **37 new works by 40 authors added to PMWL in November**

### ***PM World Collection grows to 3,328 project management articles, papers & other works by 1,492 different authors in more than 65 countries***

15 November 2019 – Dallas, London, Sydney – PM World has announced that 37 new articles, papers and other original works about program and project management have been added to the PM World Library (PMWL) this month. These contributions by 40 different authors representing 21 countries were published in the November 2019 edition of the *PM World Journal* (PMWJ) at <https://pmworldjournal.com/>. The new additions bring the total in the PM World Collection to 3,328 original works by 1,492 different authors in 65+ countries. The collection is growing each month by 35+ new works from many different authors; of the 40 authors this month, 13 were new to the journal and library. According to PMWL Director David Pells, “We feature works this month by many returning authors, which is great as it indicates sustaining support for the journal in many places. New authors appeared in the featured papers, second editions and book reviews categories. We also launched a new series this month by Professors Helgi Ingason and Haukur Jonasson at the University of Reykjavik in Iceland. There’s a good variety of content this month, so hopefully useful to many different readers.”

Emoh (Nigeria), Tijo Kurian (India/Libya), Hanfeng Lei (China/France), Baptiste Lestienne (France), Ezra Littman (USA), Grace Stephan Nkounkou (Congo/France), Julien Poivet (France), Shauna Skolnick (USA), Peter Walker (Canada/USA) and Yuanmiao Wang (China/France). New works from 27 authors already included in the library were also added.

“We also recently reinstated our email blast of the Table of Contents to subscribers,” Pells adds. “The PMWJ subscription process has not worked properly for the last year; now it has been fixed. If anyone wants to automatically receive each month’s table of contents, just subscribe. It’s Free to all.”
