12 January 2020 – Mumbai, India – Access to a new resource has been added to the PM World Library (PMWL) related to risk management. The new resource titled **“Increasing Project Success in China from the Perspectives of Project Risk, Methodology, Tool Use, and Organizational Support”**, is a paper by Charlie C. Chen, Makoto Nakayama, Yongyi Shou, and Danuvasin Charoen published in the International Journal of Information Technology Project Management, Volume 9, Issue 1, January-March 2018.

The authors developed a research model testing the relationship between project risk, Project Management tool used, Organizational support and Project Management methodology towards project success. 5 hypotheses were constructed taking into account the contribution of each of the factor towards project success. This was done in China through surveys conducted on 200 randomly chosen Project Management Professionals. Theoretical and practical implications were drawn from this study, of which an important one was the presence of project risk to stimulate the increased use of Project Management tools.
