31 new works by 35 authors added to PMWL in April

PM World Collection grows to 3,475 project management articles, papers & other works by 1,542 different authors in more than 70 countries

9 April 2020 – Dallas, London, Sydney – PM World has announced that 31 new articles, papers and other original works about program and project management have been added to the PM World Library (PMWL) this month. These contributions by 35 different authors representing 18 countries were published in the April 2020 edition of the *PM World Journal* (PMWJ) at <https://pmworldjournal.com/>. The new additions bring the total in the PM World Collection to 3,475 original works by 1,542 different authors in 70+ countries.
