1. 3. Project Management Tools: Some examples of project management applications are Monday.com, and Wrike among others.
4. Responsibilities of a Project Manager: Some of the core duties of a project manager are; Planning and defining projects, Schedule management, Budgeting, Progress measurement, Mentoring, Ensuring team collaboration, and Quality control.
5. How to Land a Job as a Project Manager: There is the need as a project manager to efficiently blend his/her educational background and solid work experience, and to exhibit mastery of the craft and efficiency as a project manager.
