## 32 new works added to PMWL in October

### ***PM World Collection grows to 3,698 project management articles, papers & other works by 1,598 different authors in more than 70 countries***

8 October 2020 – Dallas, London, Sydney – PM World has announced that 32 new articles, papers and other original works about program and project management have been added to the PM World Library (PMWL) this month. These contributions by 32 different authors representing 16 different countries were published in the October 2020 edition of the *PM World Journal* (PMWJ) at <https://pmworldjournal.com/>. The new additions bring the total in the PM World Collection to 3,698 original works by 1,598 different authors in 70+ countries. The collection is growing each month by 30+ new works from many different authors; of the 32 authors this month, 9 were new to the journal and library. New authors this month include Prof Maria Beliakova (Russia), Dr. Yang Chu (China), Elmar Kutsch (Germany/UK), Jason Loman (USA), Mandla Lusenga (South Africa), Adedotun Ojo (UK), Christopher Pye (UK), Cecile Schultz (South Africa) and Michal Vondruska (Czech Republic). New works from 23 authors already included in the library were also added.

“The featured papers and series articles are especially good this month,” Pells adds. “Iain Fraser is both an author of a series article as well as the subject of an interview by Yu Yanjuan of PMR in Beijing, which we have republished this month. Alfonso Bucero has authored both a correspondent report and an advisory article, both worth reading. Thanks to all of our contributors this month. Read their works.”
