30 new works added to PMWL in October

PM World Collection grows to 3,753 project management articles, papers & other works by 1,602 different authors in more than 70 countries

10 November 2020 – Dallas, London, Sydney – PM World has announced that 30 new articles, papers and other original works about program and project management have been added to the PM World Library (PMWL) this month. “Two papers by Bob Prieto, another regular author, are included this month, a new one in the featured papers category and an older one among the second editions.” Pells adds. “Bob is a former senior executive of two of the world’s largest engineering/construction companies and a globally-respected expert on mega projects and programs. I also want to mention new contributions from other regular contributors, including Charles Villanyi Bokor in Canada, Alfonso Bucero in Spain, Dr. Lalamani Budeli in South Africa, Dr. David Hillson in UK, Angelica Larios in Mexico, Kik Piney in France, John Schlichter in the USA, Miles Shepherd in UK, Dr. Jouko Vaskimo in Finland, Rebecca Winston in the USA and Yu Yanjuan (Spring) in China.
