30 new works added to PMWL in December

PM World Collection grows to 3,791 project management articles, papers & other works by 1,604 different authors in more than 70 countries

10 December 2020 – Dallas, London, Sydney – PM World has announced that 30 new articles, papers and other original works about program and project management have been added to the PM World Library (PMWL) this month. These contributions by 30 different authors representing 15 different countries were published in the December 2020 edition of the *PM World Journal* (PMWJ) at <https://peworldjournal.com/>. The new additions bring the total in the PM World Collection to 3,791 original works by 1,604 different authors in 70+ countries. The collection is growing each month by 30+ new works from many different authors; of the 30 authors this month, 2 were new to the journal and library. According to PMWJ Editor David Pells, “This was our 100th monthly edition, a milestone that I’m proud of. The PMWJ could only keep going though with continued contributions and support from our many authors and PM leaders around the world. Several stepped up this month with some great new works. As Darren Dalcher informed me with his new article, ‘I wasn’t going to miss this special edition’.”

New authors this month include Gareth Pugsley (UK) and Dr. Lidia Strigari (Italy). New works from 28 authors already included in the library were also added.

“As some readers may have noticed, since 2019 we’ve been providing recommended citations for all works published in the PMWJ. We’re even creating citations for letters to the editor and book reviews, as these also often include new knowledge. In addition, most citations are now also being posted in the PM World Library immediately on publication in the journal. For example, you will now find many PMWJ citations in the section of the library titled ‘Applications and Hot Topics’. Many new works published in the PMWJ are truly significant new contributions to the PM field, so we want them to become as visible and useful as possible. The authors also deserve the added recognition.”
