29 new works added to PM World Library

PM World Collection grows to 3,901 project management articles, papers & other works by 1,623 different authors in more than 70 countries

10 March 2021– Dallas, London, Sydney – PM World has announced that 29 new articles, papers and other original works about program and project management have been added to the PM World Library (PMWL) this month. These contributions by 25 different authors representing 10 different countries were published in the March 2021 edition of the *PM World Journal* (PMWJ) at <https://pmworldjournal.com/>. The new additions bring the total in the PM World Collection to 3,901 original works by 1,623 different authors in 70+ countries. The collection is growing each month by an average of 30+ new works from many different authors; of the 25 authors this month, 7 were new to the journal and library. According to PMWJ Editor David Pells, “This 103rd edition again included contributions in many categories, including two interviews, five featured papers, five series articles, four advisory articles, three commentaries, two reports and two second editions. The third of my editorials on ‘Project Management needs a Higher Purpose’ was also included.”

New authors this month include Robert Carlson (USA), Ryan Daugherty (USA), Andrew Day (UK), Pier Luigi Guida (Italy), Maurizio Monassi (Italy), Jay Pulanco (USA) and Adriana Solomón. New works from 18 authors already included in the library were also added.

“I was delighted to publish four works in direct response to my recent editorials,” Pells adds. “The featured paper by Bob Prieto titled ‘Reversing Global Warming’ is particularly interesting, as are the three commentary articles. I hope we can publish more works related to projects and project management aimed at solving global problems, the black elephants like climate change, poverty, water scarcity and corruption.”
