## 31 new works added to PM World Library

### ***PM World Collection grows to 3,931 project management articles, papers & other works by 1,627 different authors in more than 70 countries***

10 April 2021– Dallas, London, Sydney – PM World has announced that 31 new articles, papers and other original works about program and project management have been added to the PM World Library (PMWL) this month. These contributions by 32 different authors representing 17 different countries were published in the April 2021 edition of the *PM World Journal* (PMWJ) at <https://peworldjournal.com/>. They can now be found among the most recent papers, articles and book reviews on the PMWL home page at <https://peworldlibrary.net/>.

The new additions bring the total in the PM World Collection to 3,931 original works by 1,627 different authors in 70+ countries. The collection is growing each month by an average of 30+ new works from many different authors; of the 32 authors this month, 5 were new to the journal and library. According to PMWJ Editor David Pells, “This edition contains the final part 4 of my long editorial on a higher purpose for the PM profession, which I hope more people read. Not surprisingly, this edition also includes two papers about project management in healthcare, and one specifically related to the current Covid-19 pandemic. Both papers are from authors in Italy where this is still an acute national issue. Two commentary articles are related to the general topic of PM in society, Alan Stretton’s article directly responding to part 2 of my editorial in February and Reinhard Wagner’s article discussing the state of PM in German society. I think these topics are growing in importance and visibility in the PM field.”

New authors this month include Donatus Chikwendu Azunna (Nigeria), Luna E. Bassey (Nigeria), Dave Ellison (USA), Alexey Lubzov (Russia) and Marianna Spezie (Italy). New works from 27 authors already included in the library were also added.

“We had two featured papers each from Italy, Nigeria and the USA this month, and one each from authors in France and Russia,” Pells adds. “Such a good diversity in sources, perspectives and types of works. The series articles are serious contributions, the advisories good and commentaries very interesting. The two interviews this month are enlightening, the reports entertaining and the second editions worth collecting. I hope you enjoy reading.”
