### Mohamad-Fadl Haraké joins PMWL research team in France

#### *Doctoral student at University of Poitiers appointed research scholar for the PM World Library*

18 April 2021 – Dallas, TX, USA and Poitiers, France – PM World has announced the appointment of **Mr. Mohamad-Fadl Haraké** as a PM World Library research scholar. Mohamad-Fadl is a Doctoral Researcher at CEREGE EA 1722 (the Management Research Center of the University of Poitiers which is one of the oldest and most prestigious French public universities. The school is part of the IAE network - the French public reference for management and one of the largest French communities in the business and management sciences).

He is also an academic expert in the High Council for Evaluation of Research and Higher Education (Hcéres) in France. He has been affiliated with academic bodies (universities and research centers) based in France, Spain, and Lebanon as a lecturer and researcher. He is also the general secretary of the Académie de Recherche en Gestion et Economie (ARGE) and co-director of the Centre de Recherche Francophone en Economie et Gestion (CREFEGE).



M.F. Haraké's doctoral research studies public entrepreneurship in post-conflict countries. In this context, he is examining the project management dynamic of non-governmental transnational entities that are referred to as "Public Entrepreneurs" who are participating in the re-building of the public sector in post-conflict countries. The thesis will offer a new managerial perspective that aims to enable public-sector project managers to take the actions necessary to create project deliverables that meet socio-organizational needs.

According to Mr. Haraké, "I am indeed very interested in this program and believe that I can benefit a lot from it. I also look forward to contributing more input to the PM World Journal based on recent research, in Europe in general and in France in particular. I am happy to mention that two of my papers are already in the library."

He is researching critically important project management topics, especially public sector projects in post-conflict states. These are projects where lives depend on project success.
