28 new works added to PM World Library

PM World Collection grows to 3,957 project management articles, papers & other works by 1,635 authors in more than 70 countries

10 May 2021– Dallas, London, Sydney – PM World has announced that 28 new articles, papers and other original works about program and project management have been added to the PM World Library (PMWL) this month. These contributions by 34 different authors representing 16 different countries were published in the May 2021 edition of the *PM World Journal* (PMWJ) at <https://peworldjournal.com/>. New works from 25 authors already included in the library were also added.

“The four series articles are also great this month, including the guest article by the ever popular Peter Taylor,” Pells adds. “Alan Stretton has authored two must-read works this month. The advisory article, reports and second editions add to another worthwhile edition. I hope readers will agree.”
