Dr. Virginie Nahas joins PMWL research team in Kuwait

Assistant Professor at American University of the Middle East appointed research scholar for the PM World Library

Recently, Dr. Nahas joined AUM where she is pursuing her passion for teaching and research. AUM is a leading higher education institution in Kuwait, described as an “Oasis of Learning”. It is ranked among the Top 1,000 universities in the World according to QS World University Rankings.

Her research interests focus on three main pillars: the financing of SMEs in developing countries, sustainable/green finance and entrepreneurship. In this context, Her research examines a key element and a very important aspect of PM which is project financial management, including the processes to acquire and manage the financial resources for projects, particularly in developing economies.

According to Virginie, “This scholar program should enable more connections and cooperation with fellow researchers around the world to further contribute to PM knowledge. I look forward to participating in several research works and to working with PM World.”
