2020 Editor's Choice Awards – Articles Category

Awards announced for articles published in the PM World Journal during 2020

25 May 2021 – Dallas, London, Sydney – PM World has announced the winners of Editor's Choice Awards for articles published in the *PM World Journal* (PMWJ) during 2020. 120 original articles were published in the PMWJ in 2020, by authors around the world. Nine articles by authors in six different countries were selected as award winners, with another nine authors recognized by Honorable Mention.

Editor's Choice Awards are selected each year by the Managing Editor of the PMWJ based on perceived importance to the project management field, perceived value or usefulness to readers, and quality of the writing.
