24 new works added to PM World Library

PM World Collection grows to 3,980 project management articles, papers & other works by 1,640 authors in more than 70 countries

10 June 2021– Dallas, London, Sydney – PM World has announced that 24 new articles, papers and other original works about program and project management have been added to the PM World Library (PMWL) this month. These contributions by 23 different authors representing 16 different countries were published in the June 2021 edition of the *PM World Journal* (PMWJ) at <https://peworldjournal.com/>. They can now be found among the most recent papers, articles and book reviews on the PMWL home page at <https://peworldlibrary.net/>.

The new additions bring the total in the PM World Collection to 3,980 original works by 1,640 different authors located around the world. The collection is growing each month by an average of 25-35 new works from many different authors; of the 23 authors this month, five were new to the journal and library. According to PMWJ Editor David Pells, “Diversity continues to drive the journal contents, with authors this month in many different countries and topics across the board. With works in a variety of categories, including interviews, featured papers, series, advisories and commentaries, the perspectives and contexts also really varied. We also republished three papers from the April University of Maryland’s annual PM symposium, for which we act as a media partner, which also increased the depth this month.”

New authors this month include Benjamin Anyacho (USA), Nana Kwame (USA), Dr. Uju. Callista Okoye (Nigeria), Allesandro Quagliarini (Italy) and Sakhar Al-Yousfi (Yemen). New works from 19 authors already included in the library were also added.

“We were very happy to publish the first report by new correspondent, Allesandro Quagliarini in Rome,” Pells adds. “His report is excellent, describing Italy’s broad post-Pandemic economic recovery programme. I am also grateful for the great new reports from Miles Shepherd in UK, Jouko Vaskimo in Finland and Ipek Ozguler in Turkey this month. They’re all tremendous!”
