21 new works added to PM World Library

PM World Collection grows to 4063 project management articles, papers & other works by 1,674 authors in more than 50 countries

12 September 2021– Dallas, London, Sydney – PM World has announced that 21 new articles, papers and other original works about program and project management have been added to the PM World Library (PMWL) this month. These contributions by 24 different authors representing 13 different countries were published in the September 2021 edition of the *PM World Journal* (PMWJ) at <https://pmworldjournal.com/>. The new additions bring the total in the PM World Collection to 4,063 original works by 1,674 different authors located around the world. The collection is growing each month by an average of 30+ new works from many different authors; of the 24 authors this month, 7 were new to the journal and library. According to PMWJ Editor David Pells, “This was one of the slimmest editions in a long time, with fewer articles, papers and authors. But the works included are very good, so value to readers should still be high. Many of our regular authors stepped up with new works in nearly every category. The two interviews are very interesting, as are the advisory and commentary articles, while the featured papers and case study make significant contributions to the PM field.”

New authors this month include Torill Bigg (UK), Dakoriama Kelly George (Nigeria), Timothy Grayson (Canada), Yasmina Khelifi (France), Ekwelem Okechukwu (Nigeria), Michael Okongwu (Nigeria), Kartikeyan Ramamurthy (India) and Gaurang Vora (India). New works from 16 authors already included in the library were also added.

“The reports are all excellent this month,” Pells adds. “The report by Kartik Ramamurthy, our newest correspondent in India, marks the launch of a new collaboration between the PMWJ and the PMO Global Alliance India Hub. The advisory article on leadership is also by PMOGA India Hub member Gaurang Vora. We look forward to publishing more works by this dynamic new network of PMO professionals.”
