24 new works added to PM World Library

PM World Collection grows to 4086 project management articles, papers & other works by 1,679 authors in more than 50 countries

9 October 2021– Dallas, London, Sydney – PM World has announced that 24 new articles, papers and other original works about program and project management have been added to the PM World Library (PMWL) this month. These contributions by 23 different authors representing 14 different countries were published in the October 2021 edition of the *PM World Journal* (PMWJ) at <https://peworldjournal.com/>. The new additions bring the total in the PM World Collection to 4,086 original works by 1,679 different authors located around the world. The collection is growing each month by an average of 20-30+ new works from many different authors; of the 23 authors this month, 5 were new to the journal and library. New authors this month include Antonio Bassi (Switzerland), Joshua Farnsworth (UK), Margaret Shoults (USA), Ram Tavva (India) and Al Zeitoun (USA). New works from 18 authors already included in the library were also added.

“Our correspondents really stepped up this month,” Pells adds. “Four of our newest correspondents, Antonio Bassi in Lugano, Yasmina Khelifi in Paris, Kartik Ramamurthy in Bengaluru and Alessandro Quagliarini in Rome, authored great reports. Yasmina, Spring in Beijing and Ipek Sahra Ozguler in Turkey produced very interesting interviews with PM thought leaders. Angelica Larios in Mexico City provided another good advisory article. And Jouko Vaskimo and Miles Shepherd provided their usual timely and informative updates from Finland and the UK, respectively. We truly appreciate their efforts.”
