Antonio Nieto-Rodriguez named PMWJ Honorary Global Advisor

PMI Fellow, former PMI Chair joins global advisory team for PM World Journal and Library

Antonio is also the author of "[Lead Successful Projects](#)" (Penguin, 2019), "[The Project Revolution](#)" (LID, 2019), and "[The Focused Organization](#)" (Taylor&Francis, 2014), and has contributed to seven other books. He is a pioneer and leading authority in teaching and coaching senior executives the art and science of strategy implementation and project management. Currently visiting professor at Duke CE, Instituto de Empresa, Solvay, Vlerick, Ecole des Ponts, and Skolkovo.

Born in Madrid, Spain, and educated in Germany, Mexico, Italy, and the United States, Antonio is fluent in five languages.
