## **25 new works added to PM World Library**

***PM World Collection grows to 4164 project management articles, papers & other works by 1,700 authors in more than 50 countries***

14 January 2022– Dallas, London, Sydney – PM World has announced that 25 new articles, papers and other original works about program and project management have been added to the PM World Library (PMWL) this month. These contributions by 26 different authors representing 15 different countries were published in the December 2021 edition of the *PM World Journal* (PMWJ) at <https://pmworldjournal.com/>. The new additions bring the total in the PM World Collection to 4,164 original works by 1,700 different authors located around the world. The collection is growing each month by an average of 25-30+ new works from many different authors; of the 26 authors this month, 4 were new to the journal and library. New authors this month include Marco Caressa (Italy), Claudio Olivieri (Australia), Obi Omoregie (UAE) and Angela Willhoite (USA). New works from 22 authors already included in the library were also added.

“Bob Prieto’s article on ‘The Role of Trust in Project s’ is powerful and highly relevant for everyone,” Pells adds. “The article by Paul Giammalvo is both controversial and highly useful, while the one by Dr. Michael Marshall addresses a highly-visible issue in the United States this year, the ‘great resignation’ of people from their jobs. Of course, the reports and other works this month are also well worth reading, so please do.”
