### **33 new works added to PM World Library**

#### ***PM World Collection grows to 4223 project management articles, papers & other works by 1,713 authors in more than 50 countries***

15 March 2022 – Dallas, London, Sydney – PM World has announced that 33 new articles, papers and other original works about program and project management have been added to the PM World Library (PMWL) this month. These contributions by 31 different authors representing 14 different countries were published in the March 2022 edition of the *PM World Journal* (PMWJ) at <https://peworldjournal.com/>. They can now be found among the most recent papers and articles on the PMWL home page at <https://peworldlibrary.net/>.

The new additions bring the total in the PM World Collection to 4,223 original works by 1,713 different authors located around the world. The collection is growing each month by an average of 25-30+ new works from many different authors; of the 31 authors this month, six were new to the journal and library. According to PMWJ Managing Editor David Pells, “This was another strong edition with four excellent interviews, three featured papers, nine powerful series articles, nine interesting advisory and commentary articles and three great reports. There is also an interesting history of the PM program at the University of Maryland included, courtesy of Prof John Cable.”

New authors this month include Dr. Sheiff Hashem (Qatar), Sinaye Mgolombane (South Africa), Audrey Mphala (South Africa), Jürgen Oschadleus (Australia), Linda Ottmann (Germany) and Christopher Worsley (South Africa). New works from 25 authors already included in the library were also added.

“The expansion of our Series category of articles is reflected this month,” Pells adds. “A second article in the series on ‘project management in southern africa’ is included this month, authored by PMSA chair Sinaye Mgolombane. We also inaugurated a new series of brief risk management guides provided by recently retired UK risk authority Martin Hopkinson. In an attempt to be more proactive, we will be introducing a few more series this year, so please come back. Future issues of the PMWJ should be even more useful.”
