On the War and in Support of Ukraine

PMWJ invites articles and papers on the impact of the Russian invasion of Ukraine and Ukraine's war for survival and freedom

17 March 2022 – Dallas, London, Sydney – Project management practitioners, professionals, experts and researchers around the world are invited to submit new works for publication in the *PM World Journal* related to the current war in Ukraine resulting from Russia's invasion of that independent European country. In particular, articles and papers are sought that illustrate, describe or comment on the impact of the war on individuals, project participants, projects, organizations, industries or even economies and countries.

The PM World stands with Ukraine. Help us publish more works in support of the brave citizens of that country who are now fighting for their freedom, their lives and the future of their independent nation.

Some examples of works might include:

- Commentaries – personal opinions about the Russian invasion of Ukraine, the war itself or the effects of this war being felt worldwide already and in the future. The largest refugee crisis since World War II is one example; could this lead to World War III or nuclear war is another. The ramifications already seem widespread.
- Advisory Articles – what actions or projects can be taken to help Ukraine, refugees or others in similar situations? What approaches or considerations are needed in such emergencies? How can project management advance survival, defense or success?
- Personal Stories – If you are in Ukraine, or know someone there, please share your experience. If you have experience with a project related to war or its aftermath, please share it now.
- Case studies – stories about projects that can be related to what's going on in Ukraine, either in defense of the country or in response to current emergencies and emerging conditions.
- Featured Papers – surveys or research of any kind related to the current war, or the aftermath of conflict. Is there a body of knowledge on this aspect of project management?
