30 new works added to PM World Library

PM World Collection grows to 4308 project management articles, papers & other works by 1,729 authors in more than 50 countries

15 June 2022 – Dallas, London, Sydney – PM World has announced that 30 new articles, papers and other original works about program and project management have been added to the PM World Library (PMWL) this month. These contributions by 38 different authors representing 14 different countries were published in the June 2022 edition of the *PM World Journal* (PMWJ) at <https://peworldjournal.com>. The new additions bring the total in the PM World Collection to 4,308 original works by 1,729 different authors located around the world. The collection is growing each month by an average of 30-40+ new works from many different authors; of the 38 authors this month, 14 were new to the journal and library. According to PMWJ Managing Editor David Pells, “This was another full and diverse edition with three letters to the editor, three interviews, three featured papers, four good series articles, five interesting advisory and commentary articles, and four great reports. We’re also publishing more second edition papers and book reviews again, four of each this month. The featured paper by Bob Prieto and commentary by Alan Stretton are especially strong, but all the works this month are worth reading.”

New authors this month include Giacomo Amorati (Switzerland), Jonathan Bertossa (Switzerland), Krystal Blackwell (USA), Mark Brauer (Switzerland), Katuscya Gianini (Switzerland), Daniel Harrier (USA), Rodney Ivester (USA), Joseph Kuntz (USA), Mohammad Mobashin (USA), Michela Mondia (Switzerland), Celine Saavedra (USA), Giovanni Sciagura (Switzerland), Malte Scholz (Germany) and Simona Tesclat (Switzerland). New works from 24 authors already included in the library were also added.

“The expansion of our Series category continued this month with a new series on ‘Quick Tips for Team Leaders’ by Jeff Oltmann,” Pells adds. “Over the next few months, we will be republishing more papers from recent PM symposia sponsored by the University of Maryland and University of Texas at Dallas. This month’s selections were interesting, relevant and very well written.”
