32 new works added to PM World Library

PM World Collection grows to 4374 project management articles, papers & other works by 1,764 authors in 90 countries

15 August 2022 – Dallas, London, Sydney – PM World has announced that 32 new articles, papers and other original works about program and project management have been added to the PM World Library (PMWL) this month. These contributions by 34 different authors representing 17 different countries were published in the August 2022 edition of the *PM World Journal* (PMWJ) at <https://pmworldjournal.com/>. The new additions bring the total in the PM World Collection to 4,374 original works by 1,764 different authors located around the world.
