27 new works added to PM World Library

PM World Collection grows to 4455 project management articles, papers & other works by 1,787 authors in more than 50 countries

15 November 2022 – Dallas, London, Sydney – PM World has announced that 27 new articles, papers and other original works about program and project management have been added to the PM World Library (PMWL) this month. These contributions by 33 different authors representing 14 different countries were published in the November 2022 edition of the *PM World Journal* (PMWJ) at <https://peworldjournal.com/>. The new additions bring the total in the PM World Collection to 4,455 original works by 1,787 different authors located around the world. The collection is growing each month by an average of 25-35+ new works from many different authors; of the 33 authors this month, six were new to the journal and library. New authors this month include Felice Corini (Italy), Geoffrey Nwodo (Nigeria), Joseph Aderemi Akinola (Nigeria), Emmanuel Ukanwa (Nigeria), Chukwuemeka Nwosu, PhD (Nigeria) and Greg Saunders (USA). New works from 27 authors already included in the library were also added.

“We are more than happy to publish papers from Nigeria, as there are well-established project management programs at many universities there, as well as PM professional organizations,” Pells adds. “In addition, Nigeria is an English-speaking country and we have many readers there. The same is true for India, Pakistan and several other countries, so let us continue to respect and learn from one another.”
