### 28 new works added to PM World Library

#### **PM World Collection grows to 4516 project management articles, papers & other works by 1,797 authors in more than 90 countries**

16 January 2023 – Dallas, London, Sydney – PM World has announced that 28 new articles, papers and other original works about program and project management have been added to the PM World Library (PMWL) this month. These contributions by 26 different authors representing 13 different countries were published in the January 2023 edition of the *PM World Journal* (PMWJ) at <https://peworldjournal.com/>. The new additions bring the total in the **PM World Collection** to 4,516 original works by 1,797 different authors located around the world. The collection is growing each month by an average of 25-35+ new works from many different authors; of the 26 authors this month, three were new to the journal and library. New authors this month include Prof Yongkang Cao (China), Mehta Vatsal (USA) and Iliya Mela (China/Nigeria). New works from 23 authors already included in the library were also added.

“I was most pleased with the Series articles; five regular authors contributed great articles and I am thrilled to introduce two new series this month,” Pells adds. “Dr. Stanislaw Gasik in Poland has authored the first in a new series of articles titled “Let’s talk about public projects” based on his newly published book “*Projects, Government and Public Policy*.” Yasmina has authored the first in a new bi-monthly series on “Making a Modern Project Manager. These are going to be great new series for the PMWJ!”
