26 new works added to PM World Library

PM World Collection grows to 4544 project management articles, papers & other works by 1,803 authors in more than 90 countries

14 February 2023 – Dallas, London, Sydney – PM World has announced that 26 new articles, papers and other original works about program and project management have been added to the PM World Library (PMWL) this month. These contributions by 27 different authors representing 16 different countries were published in the February 2023 edition of the *PM World Journal* (PMWJ) at <https://peworldjournal.com/>. The new additions bring the total in the **PM World Collection** to 4,544 original works by 1,803 different authors located around the world. The collection is growing each month by an average of 25-35+ new works from many different authors; of the 26 authors this month, six were new to the journal and library. According to PMWJ Managing Editor David Pells, “These new additions to the library reflect the wide variety of outstanding works being published in the PMWJ each month. The works were also in many categories, including interviews, featured papers, series articles, advisories, commentaries, reports, second editions, book reviews and a student paper. With 16 countries represented among the authors, these works are also the most global of recent months.

New authors this month include Marc Crotty (USA), Dora Jara (USA), Michael Frahm (Germany), Dr. Martin Pfiffner (Switzerland), Amalia Quintaro (Venezuela, Ecuador, USA) and Zavier Naafi Rahmansyah (Indonesia). New works from 20 authors already included in the library were also added.

“I was especially happy to publish a really outstanding paper by a high school senior in Jakarta, Indonesia” Pells adds. “I also appreciate the many contributions made by our correspondents, series authors and such regular contributors as Alan Stretton in Australia and Ken Smith in The Philippines. All the new works this month really are outstanding and worth reading.”
