33 new works added to PM World Library

PM World Collection grows to 4578 project management articles, papers & other works by 1,811 authors in 90+ countries

15 March 2023 – Dallas, London, Sydney – PM World has announced that 33 new articles, papers and other original works about program and project management have been added to the PM World Library (PMWL) this month. These contributions by 34 different authors representing 17 different countries were published in the March 2023 edition of the *PM World Journal* (PMWJ) at https://pmworldjournal.com/. New authors this month include Jesus Martinez Almela (Spain), Kevin Darbelnet (USA), Maria Davies (USA), Mahmoud Desouky (Qatar), Brenda Kwateng (USA), Sre Sudharsan (India), Ricardo Viana Vargas (Portugal/Brazil) and Phoebe Were (USA). New works from 20 authors already included in the library were also added.

"We are also trying to include more Second Editions, older papers that deserve new attention like the four this month" Pells adds. "More book reviews are also coming in, which also add interesting content. Our book reviews are intended to not only critique PM books but also create a little new knowledge, based on the reviewer's knowledge and insights. So please don't' ignore this section of the journal each month."
