## Free PM World Library Membership available for residents of Ukraine

Free access to online global resource related to program and project management for those living and working in Ukraine

23 March 2023 - Dallas, TX, USA and Kyiv, Ukraine - PM World has announced that residents of Ukraine can register for FREE ACCESS to the PM World Library (PMWL) at www.pmworldlibrary.net. The PMWL is a global resource for continuous learning related to program, project and portfolio management.

According to PM World Library Director David Pells (pictured at right in Istanbul, Turkey), "We were already offering free access to those in many low income countries, including Ukraine. In support of Ukrainian professionals who are now defending their country against the Russian invasion, I thought we should make this free access more visible once more."

Those working or living in Ukraine can register for FREE BASIC ACCESS to the PMWL at http://pmworldlibrary.net/who-getsfree-basic-access/. Follow the instructions for residents of low-

income countries. If any problems are encountered, contact editor@pmworld.net.

"We first announced this policy in 2014 following Russia's unlawful annexation of Crimea," Pells adds. "We should have re-announced this free membership months ago when the current war began. I've been reminded recently that both the PMI Ukraine chapter and the IPMA member association in Ukraine are alive and growing again. So let us support them now even more. Also, I first visited Ukraine in 1992 and still have friends there, so this is also personal to me!"

Others offered free access to the PMWL include students, professors and residents of around 80 countries listed as low-income by the World Bank. (See the list of countries for Free Access at http://pmworldlibrary.net/free-basic-access/.) For most there is a small membership fee, about the cost of a cup of coffee in most countries.
