39 new works added to PM World Library

PM World Collection grows to 4618 project management articles, papers & other works by 1,824 authors in 90+ countries

19 April 2023 – Dallas, London, Sydney – PM World has announced that 39 new articles, papers and other original works about program and project management have been added to the PM World Library (PMWL) this month. These contributions by 46 different authors representing 18 different countries were published in the April 2023 edition of the *PM World Journal* (PMWJ) at https://pmworldjournal.com/. The new additions bring the total in the **PM World Collection** to 4,618 original works by 1,824 different authors located around the world. "The second edition papers and book reviews also increase the contents this month, as they do most months" Pells adds. "In addition, our correspondents from around the world are submitting more reports than ever. This is great, as the reports provide us with some snapshots of what's going on around the PM world each month. So don't miss reading the reports."
