Organisational PM Capability

At GAPPS TLF#54 several experts shared their knowledge of and experience with organisational PM capability standards, guides, models, and excellence frameworks. At TLF#55 it was agreed that although there are many models out there, they are either proprietary, not readily available, or don't provide a practical basis for assessment and improvement. At TLF#57, we will continue work on a freely available assessment model for OPM capability by looking at the approach and coverage of existing frameworks.

Program Manager Framework update

GAPPS Program Manager Guiding Framework was published in 2011 and it is time to have another look at it and bring it up to date.

At this TLF we will finalise review of feedback from public review and update the framework.

PPPM Standards – Update & Mapping

Standards for PPPM are evolving. Learn what is happening in PPPM standards development and contribute to the GAPPS comparative mapping of global standards and qualifications.
