# 36 new works added to PM World Library

## **PM World Collection grows to 4761 project management articles, papers & other works by 1,869 authors in 90+ countries**

15 August 2023 – Dallas, London, Sydney – PM World has announced that 36 new articles, papers and other original works about program and project management have been added to the PM World Library (PMWL) this month. These contributions by 39 different authors in 19 different countries were published in the August 2023 edition of the *PM World Journal* (PMWJ) at <https://peworldjournal.com/>. The new additions bring the total in the **PM World Collection** to 4,761 original works by 1,869 different authors located around the world. The collection is growing each month by 30-40 new works from many different authors; of the 39 authors this month, nine were new to the journal and library. According to PMWJ Managing Editor David Pells, “This edition contains a whopping nine featured papers by 11 authors in eight different countries, and eight series articles by leading project management experts in seven different countries. The variety of works and the diversity of author locations and backgrounds contained in the PMWJ continues to grow. It’s very rewarding to attract so many contributions each month.”

New authors this month include: Nse Akpan Bassey (Nigeria), Obaidul Khandaker (Bangladesh/USA), Manish Mattawar (USA), Achmad Purwadi (Indonesia), George Sammit (USA), Edward Spence (USA), Kemberly Stephens (USA), Wajahat Ullah (Pakistan) and Gopinath Venu (USA). New works from 30 authors already included in the library were also added.

“Combined with excellent advisory and commentary articles,” Pells adds. “along with reports from multiple locations creates a truly global resource each month. Friendly alliances with other organizations ensure a steady stream of second editions and book reviews each month, so the journal continues to grow. This variety increases the likelihood that we are creating and sharing PM knowledge around the world.”
