Who might benefit from the Book?

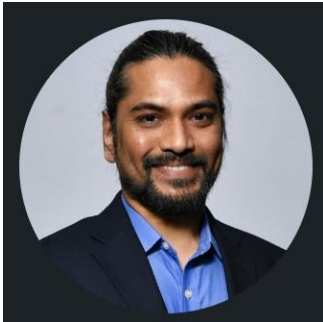
