## 32 new works added to PM World Library

PM World Collection grows to 4799 project management articles, papers & other works by 1,881 authors in 90+ countries

8 September 2023 - Dallas, London, Sydney - PM World has announced that 32 new articles, papers and other original works about program and project management have been added to the PM World Library (PMWL) this month. These contributions by 33 different authors in 13 different countries were published in the September 2023 edition of the PM World Journal (PMWJ) at https://pmworldjournal.com/. They can now be found among the most recent papers and articles on the PMWL home page at https://pmworldlibrary.net/.

The new additions bring the total in the **PM World Collection** to 4,799 original works by 1,881 different authors located around the world. The collection is growing each month by 30-40 new works from many different authors; of the 33 authors this month, 12 were new to the journal and library. Profiles of all authors in the library,

According to PMWJ Managing Editor David Pells, "This is a very interesting edition this month. There are two letters to the editor on the meaning of terms, an interesting interview on the use of neuroscience in project management, seven serious featured papers, five series articles by true PM experts, even a personal story about applying PM to achieve a personal dream project."

New authors this month include: Norah Almadani (USA), Royan Nur Huda (Indonesia), Karolina Jarocka (Poland), Lance Lawshe (USA), Nina Ratna Enggar Puspita (Indonesia), Eureka Saunders (USA), Toni Smith (USA), Cahyo Sukmono (Indonesia), Victor Tabi (USA), Angela Thronburg (USA) and Mark Wettreich (USA). New works from 21 authors already included in the library were also added.

"The two advisory articles should also be highly useful to some readers," Pells adds. "Alan Stretton has concluded his two-part assessment of PMI's 2021 standard updates, and we've republished three more conference papers in the Second Editions section. Add in seven book reviews and there is a lot of knowledge being shared this month. This really is exactly what the PMWJ is intended for."
