Darci Prado, PhD appointed PMWJ Honorary Industry Advisor in Brazil

Creator of the Prado-Project Management Maturity Model joins honorary advisory team for PM World Journal and Library

His books have sold over 100k copies, mainly in Brazil, but also in Italy and Spain. He has published dozens of articles and papers in various media, such as PM World Journal and MundoPM.

Mr. Prado graduated in Engineering from the Federal University of Minas Gerais – UFMG (1970) and obtained a Ph.D in Engineering from UNICAMP (2011). He was a Professor at the UFMG School of Engineering from 1971 to 2004 and worked at IBM between 1971 and 1995. He was one of the founders of PMI chapters in Minas Gerais State and Paraná State, and president of the Minas Gerais chapter of IPMA between 2006 and 2008.
