28 new works added to PM World Library

PM World Collection grows to 4,884 project management articles, papers & other works by 1,915 authors in 90+ countries

13 December 2023 – Dallas, London, Sydney – PM World has announced that 28 new articles, papers and other original works about program and project management have been added to the PM World Library (PMWL) this month. These contributions by authors in 14 different countries were published in the December 2023 edition of the *PM World Journal* (PMWJ) at <https://peworldjournal.com/>. The new additions bring the total in the **PM World Collection** to 4,884 original works by 1,915 different authors located around the world. The collection is growing each month by 25-35 new works from many different authors; of the 28 authors this month, 7 were new to the journal and library.
