He was an adjunct professor at post-graduate level for ESC Lille (now SKEMA), France, Université Mundiapolis, Morocco, and University of Technology Sydney (UTS), Australia. He is PMI Authorized Training Partner (ATP) Instructor for PMP, DASM, DASSM, DAC, DAVSC, PMI-CP.

Michel graduated as an Architect at the Université de Montréal; he has obtained an MSc in Organizational Behaviour with the School of Management and Organizational Behaviour at the University of London and a PhD on the Contextualisation of Project Organizations at Middlesex University in the UK. In 2006 he was elected *PMI Fellow* for his continued contribution to project management. In 2008, he was awarded a *Life Achievement Award* by the Canadian Society of Value Analysis of which he was a co-founder. In 2014, he was awarded the *PMI Eric Jenett Project Management Excellence Award* for outstanding contributions to the practice of the profession, and leadership in advancing PM concepts, techniques, practices, or theories.
