Roberto Mori has been member of the Italian National Association of Plant Engineering (ANIMP) since the early 90's, taking major parts in the activities performed by its Project Management Section, IPMA Italy, of which he was President until February 2015. He was Chairman of the International Project Management Association (IPMA) 2013- 2014, after having served as Vice President and President for four years. He has been Prize Winner of the IPMA Project Excellence Award 2006 and obtained the IPMA Otto Zieglmeier's Award for Excellent Project Management Performance in 2008. Former member of the IPMA EU Task Force for the relationship with EU Institutions, past Chairman of IPMA Ethics Committee, today he is Chairman of IPMA Advisory Committee 2024 – 2026.
