# GAPPS TLF#61: 27<sup>th</sup> – 28<sup>th</sup> September 2024

## Workstreams

### Sustainable project practice

A burning issue in project management, we will review work done to date over several TLF's, and continue developing a guiding framework. Contribute to this important work.

Limited positions available to join a pre-TLF tour of sustainability projects in Singapore on 24-26 September.

### Complexity Assessment Framework update

GAPPS has developed frameworks for assessing the relative complexity of projects and programs. At TLF#60 we addressed feedback from public review and discussed how such frameworks are used. At TLF#61 we will review GAPPS frameworks alongside other complexity frameworks using GAPPS mind mapping process.

### Organisational PM Capability

How can organisations prepare their projects for the future? At GAPPS TLF#54 several experts shared their knowledge of, and experience with, organisational PM capability standards, guides, models, and excellence frameworks. At TLF#55 it was agreed that although there are many models out there, they are either proprietary, not readily available, or don't provide a practical basis for assessment and improvement. At TLF#61, we will continue work on a freely available assessment model for OPM capability by looking at the approach and coverage of existing frameworks.

### PPPM Standards – Update & Mapping

Standards for PPPM are evolving. Learn what is happening in PPPM standards development and contribute to the GAPPS comparative mapping of global standards and qualifications.
