35 new works added to PM World Library in September

PM World Collection grows to 5,213 project management articles, papers & other works by 2,013 authors in 90+ countries

15 September 2024 – Dallas, London, Sydney – PM World has announced that 35 new articles, papers and other original works about program and project management have been added to the PM World Library (PMWL) this month.
