### 43 new works added to PM World Library in November

#### **PM World Collection grows to 5,257 project management articles, papers & other works by 2,035 authors in 90+ countries**

17 November 2024 – Dallas, London, Sydney – PM World has announced that 43 new articles, papers and other original works about program and project management have been added to the PM World Library (PMWL) this month. These contributions by 64 authors in 19 different countries were published in the October/November 2024 edition of the *PM World Journal* (PMWJ) at <https://pmworldjournal.com/>. The new additions bring the total in the [PM World Collection](#) to 5,257 original works by 2,035 different authors located around the world. The collection is growing each month by 30-40 new works from many different authors; of the 64 authors this month, 23 were new to the journal and library.
